Our "duty to warn" includes issues of suspected or reported child abuse, elder abuse, threats to self/suicidal tendencies, and threats to others/homicidal tendencies. In addition, occasionally judges will subpoena a counselor for testimony or order the release of confidential information in court proceedings. In these instances, the client is notified of the subpoena and/or court order and every effort is made to protect confidential information.
