Driving Time

What did you talk about this week in your small group? (Reflecting God's love by being salt and light in this world.)



Dinner Time



Being salt for Jesus means making the world a better place. If you taste food before it's been salted, it won't taste nearly as good as it does after I have seasoned it. Can you think of some ways you can be salt for Jesus and make the world a better place this week?



You may not see it, but most foods we like have been seasoned with salt. It helps food taste better. Can you think of a way we can make the world a better place?



When we love others, we bring "salt" to this world and make it better. Do you ever struggle to love others? Are there people out there you don't want to love?



Night Time



Sometimes at night people like to have a little light on. You know that good feeling you get when it's really dark and you turn a little light on? That is the same feeling you give to others when you show them the love of Jesus. Do you know someone who needs to feel Jesus' love?



As you get ready to sleep, is there anyone you know that we can pray for to see Jesus love in you this week?



Consider sharing with your child how you have shown God's love to someone recently.
