Morning Time



One of the best ways to obey Jesus is to show kindness to others. Can you think of a way to show kindness to someone today?



Your Bible lesson this week was about obeying Jesus. Do you remember if the lesson came from the Old Testament or the New Testament? (All verses were by the Apostle John, so the lesson was from the New Testament.)



Do you remember what you studied in your small group at church this week? (Showing love to Jesus by obeying Him. We obey by loving others.)



Driving Time



This week you learned about obeying God. When I am driving, I must obey the laws in order to keep us safe. What are some laws I must obey? What kind of things do you need to obey in order to stay safe?



When I drive, I have to obey all of the driving laws. What do you think would happen if I didn't obey the laws?



You studied obeying Jesus in your small group this week. It won't be too long before you're driving. Do you think it's important to obey driving laws when you drive? What do you think will happen when you drive if you don't obey the laws?



Dinner Time



You learned about obedience in your Bible lesson. Even at meal times we have certain rules we must obey. What are some of our meal rules? How do these rules help us have better meal times?



During Jesus' last meal with His disciples, He said we show we love Him when we obey Him. How do we show love to each other in our family?



Jesus said we show we love Him when we obey Him. What does the Bible say we should do to show obedience to Jesus? (We obey Jesus when we show love to others.)



Night Time



Was today a good day for you? Can you think of ways you obeyed Jesus today? Were there any times when you didn't obey Jesus today?



Before we go to sleep, is there anything you need to do to show Jesus you love Him. Can we pray about that?



Talk with your child about ways to show love to others and whether there are people in his or her life that's difficult to love.
