Morning Time



It is very important that we are kind to people who struggle with sickness or who have other problems. Do you know someone you will see today that we can pray for?



In this week's Bible story, what miracle did you learn about Jesus doing? (Jesus healed a man born blind.) What do you remember about that story?



As a parent, share with your child how you seek to see people in need around you.



Driving Time



This week you learned that Jesus heals. Jesus doesn't just heal big things like blindness. Anytime we ever get better it is because Jesus helps our bodies get better. Even if it was just from a cold. Can you remember a time when Jesus healed you or someone you know?



What do you think the blind man in Sunday's story was most excited to see after Jesus healed him?



What did you talk about in your small group this week? (Jesus healing the blind man.) Tell me something you remember about it.



Dinner Time



As a parent, share that Jesus doesn't always heal the way we want. Sometimes God has a special plan for a person that might include being sick. Talk about someone you know who may be like that.



As a parent, be candid about something sad or difficult you experienced or observed during the day. Talk about the good difference Jesus can make in people's lives, including your own.



In this week's story, Jesus gave sight to a blind man. He literally brought light to the man. We can also bring light into people's lives. How can we do that as a family?



Night Time



Sometimes healing doesn't happen quickly. Sometimes people are sick for a while. When people are sick, we can do things to help them. What kinds of things can we do to help someone who is sick?



Tell me how Jesus healed the blind man. (Jesus made mud and rubbed it on the man's eyes. Then He told the man to go and wash. When the man came back, he could see. Jesus had healed him.)



Sometimes people don't want to help those who are sick. Have you ever stopped to help someone the world might have passed by? Do you know someone who needs your love?
