Morning Time



This week you learned that Jesus prayed for His followers. Do you remember what kinds of things Jesus prayed for? (He prayed that His followers would be protected and love each other as a team works together.)



John 17 tells us that Jesus prayed. Can you remember for whom He prayed? (The disciples, and all those who would come to believe in Him in the future.)



In your Bible story this week, you learned that Jesus prayed for His disciples and even us. Can you think of someone we can pray for today?



Driving Time



Things around us are constantly changing when we drive. It reminds us that there are lots of things we can pray for just as Jesus prayed for us. Do you see something we could pray for?



Riding in a car is a good time to pray and to practice memorizing a verse. Let's pray together now, just as Jesus did. Then we can practice saying your memory verse together. (But these are written so that you may believe Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and by believing you may have life in His name. John 20:31)



What did you learn about today in your small group time? (Jesus prayed for His followers.)



Dinner Time



When Jesus prayed for His followers, he prayed that God would help them be united. Do you remember what united means? What are some ways we can show that we are united with other Christians?



Jesus prayed for His followers on an important night. What can you tell me about that night? (Jesus and His disciples had just eaten their last meal together. Jesus knew He would soon die for our sins, yet He was praying for His followers.)



As a parent, talk about your practice of prayer? Do you pray for the same people everyday? Do you pray for specific groups of people each day? Or do you pray for people as the Lord brings them to mind?



Night Time



Jesus prayed for His followers because He loved them. Who do you want to pray for tonight?



Jesus loves us so very much that He prayed for us, His followers, long, long ago. How can we show His love to people today? (Treat others with gentleness and kindness, and tell them about Jesus.)



Part of growing up is learning to think of others more than ourselves. Jesus showed He was thinking of us when He prayed for us. Who do we need to pray for tonight?
