



Discipleship in the Home



Morning Time



You just got up out of the bed. What did Jesus get out of on Resurrection Sunday morning? (Jesus was able to get out of the tomb because He is alive.)



Mary Magdalene went to Jesus' tomb early in the morning, even when it was still dark. Have you ever talked to Jesus early in the morning? Praying is a really special way to begin your day. (Share your own experience as a parent.)



Share with your child how Easter makes a difference in your everyday life---long after celebrating the holiday.



Driving Time



Sometimes when we want to go see a friend we drive there. When Mary discovered Jesus was alive, did she drive back to tell His followers? (No. They didn't have cars.) Did she walk or run? (She ran because she was excited to tell people Jesus was alive.)



When Mary Magdalene went to Jesus' tomb she was so very sad, but then something happened that she did not expect. What was that? (Jesus' body was gone from the tomb. He was alive! He talked with Mary.) God's plans may surprise us sometimes, but we can always trust His plan.



What did you talk about in your small group Bible story? (Christ's resurrection.)



Dinner Time



Why could Jesus do special things, like come back to life after three days? (Because Jesus is God's Son. We know Jesus is special because He was dead, but now Jesus is alive!)



After Mary Magdalene recognized Jesus outside the tomb, what job did Jesus give her? (To go and tell the others that He was alive.) Should we tell others about Jesus, too? (Yes.) What can we say? (That Jesus died for them because He loves them so much.)



In our story this week, we learned that Jesus overcame death and sin. As a parent, describe a time when you realized His power in your own life and were able to set aside your desire to sin.



Night Time



Jesus rose from the dead on Sunday morning. Who saw Him that Sunday morning? (Allow for response.) Yes, Mary was there. She was so glad that Jesus was alive. What did Mary do after she saw Jesus? (Mary went to tell others that Jesus was alive!)



This week we learned about Jesus being alive three days after He'd been buried. Wow, what a wise and powerful God we serve! Let's pray. Together, we can thank God that Jesus is alive.



As a parent, have you ever reflected Christ's sacrifice by setting aside your own will for others? Share with your child your experience of serving and sacrificing.
