Morning Time



As your child wakes up, remind him/her that Jesus loves him. Ask, "Who will share Jesus' love with today?"



When you give your child a hug first thing in the morning, whisper this challenge... "Be strong and brave! God can give you courage to do right when others are doing wrong." Before dropping your child off for school, whisper the same challenge... "Be strong and brave!"



Let's ask God to make us more aware today of those who don't know Jesus. Let's pray that the Holy Spirit will help us be brave and share with these people.



Driving Time



Because we have cars and phones and computers, it is really easy for us to tell others about Jesus. Can you think of someone you would like to visit, call, or send a message? Let's tell someone that Jesus loves them!



Sometimes we use a device to help us know how to get where we're going in the car. God gave us His Holy Spirit to guide us in life. If we allow our hearts to listen closely to the Spirit, He will guide us every day!



After driving a bit, we have to refuel the car. Sometimes our spirit also needs to be refueled. How can the Holy Spirit refuel our spirit? (Bible reading, prayer, church, sharing.)



Dinner Time



Our church sends missionaries all over the world. Our Long Hollow missionaries tell people that Jesus loves them. Let's pray for our missionaries now!



Jesus asked His disciples to not only tell people that lived near them about Him, but to also share His story with those who lived far away! Did you know there are some people that move to other countries to tell people about Jesus? These people are called missionaries. Let's pray for missionaries around the world.



In this week's story, Jesus commanded His followers to be His witnesses to the ends of the earth. How were you His witness today? Did you do something to show Christ's love to someone? Did you say something that would encourage someone who was discouraged?



Night Time



We don't have to fear anything, because God is with us. Let's ask God to help us be brave and tell others about Jesus today.



As a parent, tell your child about something that happened during your day that allowed you to depend on God for bravery. Ask your child to tell you ways that God helped him/her throughout the day, too.



As a parent, consider how your family's faith affects your neighborhood and your community. Ask your child to pray with you to see opportunities God gives your family to share Him in your home, neighborhood, community, and even to the ends of the earth.
