



Discipleship in the Home



Morning Time



Talk about the places your child will go today. Remind your child that God will be with him/her everywhere he/she goes.



God's Holy Spirit gave Peter and the other disciples the courage to start the first church. God can help you do great things, too! What great things do you want to do for God?



This week you learned Jesus began His church by giving the Holy Spirit. How can you depend on the Holy Spirit to make good choices today? How can the Holy Spirit equip you to tell others about Jesus?



Driving Time



Ask your child, "What is your favorite trip we've ever taken?" No matter where we go or how far away we travel, God is always with us.



Ask your child to point out different churches you pass on the drive. Ask, "What are some of your favorite things about our church? What do you think the very first church might have been like?"



Why do you think the Holy Spirit helped the first believers speak many languages? When we drive, we see people who are different than us. How can Jesus equip us to share His love with people we encounter today?



Dinner Time



God has blessed us with many things today, like this good meal. Let's take time to thank God for these blessings and to thank Him for always being with us.



God performed a miracle on the day of Pentecost by allowing every one there that day to hear Peter speak in his or her own language! What are some ways that we can help other people who do not speak our language learn about Jesus?



In our story this week, we saw Peter explain to unbelievers how to trust in Jesus. Do you remember what A-B-C helps us remember? Admit you need Jesus because you are a sinner. Believe Jesus died for your sins and rose from the grave. Commit to obey and follow Jesus.



Night Time



Talk to your child about the special items he/she sleeps with to make him/her feel comfortable and safe at night. Remind your child that God watches over him/her all night long!



God promises to always be with us, and to help us if we ask Him! God wants to help us in big things and little things! How has God helped you today?



The Holy Spirit is always with me. As a parent, consider how that truth is a comfort to you as you lead your children. Share with your children your need for the Holy Spirit in your everyday life. Share how the Holy Spirit's presence empowers, comforts, and guides you.
