Morning Time



Even if you can't read by yourself just yet, it can be good to listen to the words of God in the morning and follow along as someone reads to you. Would you like me to read you a few verses now?



What important treasure did King Josiah's helper find in the broken temple? (His helper found the "Book of the Law" - the books of Genesis - Deuteronomy.)



What was the story you looked at in Bible study? (King Josiah finding the lost Word of God.) Who was the main character in the story? (Josiah.)



Driving Time



There are lots of words along the road to help guide me as we drive. Some of the words tell me where I am going or what to do. The Bible is like that, too. It leads us so we know where to go and what to do. Can you remember some of God's instructions from his Word?



What did King Josiah do when he heard God's Word being read? (He grew sad and tore his clothes because he and his people had forgotten about God.)



What did you learn about spiritual disciplines in your Bible study this week? (That God speaks to me through His Word.)



Dinner Time



The Bible often talks about God's Word being like food. We need to eat food every day and we need to listen to God's Word every day. What can happen if we don't listen to God's Word every day?



How did King Josiah show that reading the Bible is important? (He gathered all the people into the temple and read to them God's Word. Then, he and the people promised God that they would follow God's commandments.)



Do you have a time when you read God's Word and a place where you do it? (You may wish to share with your child about your own habit of spending time in God's Word.)



Night Time



You've had a big day. I hope you've had fun, but I hope you have listened to God's Word today also. What do you remember from the Bible today?



How does reading the Bible help us? (If we love God, then we want to live in a way that pleases Him. We read the Bible to know how to live, to know God, and to hear from Him.)



Can you think of a verse from the Bible that God has used to speak to you in a personal way recently?
