



# Discipleship in the Home



## Morning Time



Talking to others about Jesus can sometimes feel difficult. It helps to practice. Why don't you pretend that I don't know who Jesus is and you are going to tell me about Him?



Who was John the Baptist? (John was Jesus' cousin. God's plan for John was to prepare the people for Jesus's ministry. John the Baptist taught the people, and he baptized the people.)



Sacrifice can seem abstract unless we make it real. Spend some time talking with your child about sin's strong hold and how we naturally don't want to obey God. Discuss how Christ's sacrifice allows us to have power to overcome sin and enables us to follow Christ.



## Driving Time



Have you ever noticed that streets have names? Names help us understand streets and even people. Do you remember what name you learned for Jesus this week? Jesus is the Messiah. Messiah means savior.



Sometimes we have to use a map or navigation device when we're driving. How was John the Baptist like a map or navigation device? (John pointed the way to Jesus and how people should live)



Sometimes when we're driving we have to make a U-turn. John the Baptist preached that people should repent from sin. How is repenting like a U-turn?



## Dinner Time



God sent Jesus to help us. What are some ways you can help others?



John the Baptist called Jesus the "Lamb of God." How was Jesus like a lamb? (Lambs were sacrificed for the forgiveness of sin. Jesus was the final sacrifice for sin.)



We enjoy a lot of good food. Do you remember what the Bible says John the Baptist ate? (Locusts and wild honey.) Why would this be important? (John was more concerned about fulfilling his mission than a comfortable lifestyle.)



## Night Time



John the Baptist told people about Jesus. Do you think he prayed for people, too? Who are some people we can pray for?



How do you know God loves you? God sent His Son Jesus to be a sacrifice for me.



If Jesus was the lamb of God, then He was a sacrifice. What did Jesus sacrifice for us and how should we live because of that sacrifice? (Jesus gave His life for us. Now we should live to honor and please Him.)
