



John 6:22-35

The Big Picture

- At one point in Jesus' ministry, He was being followed by a crowd of around 5,000 men alone. One of His more famous miracles was when He had them all sit down to eat—and then He multiplied 5 loaves of bread and 2 fish into enough food to feed all of them.
- The people were amazed and knew He was something special, but as they went to find Him the next day, He exposed the intent of their hearts and pointed out they were seeking Him for the wrong reasons.
- Jesus is the bread that God sent from Heaven not to satisfy our bellies, but to satisfy our hearts.

Discussion Questions

2. According to v. 26, why were the people seeking Jesus?
Do you think that people still come to Jesus today for similar reasons? Why or why not?
What are some “things” people want to get out of following Jesus?
3. According to verse 29, what is “the work of God”?
What was it that made you believe in Jesus?
4. What makes the people's response in vv. 30-31 so frustrating?
How can we find ourselves saying those exact same things?
5. What kind of hunger does Jesus satisfy? How has He satisfied that hunger in you? How does that encourage you to live a life of faith in Him?

Response

- Who is someone you know who needs to hear that Jesus is the only true bread that satisfies? How can you make that happen?
